

## 2019 SURVEY INDICATES 97% OF TRIBAL MEN AND THEIR FAMILIES ARE TRANSFORMED THROUGH CORE 300'S WARRIOR COURSE

For decades, social scientists and faith-based organizations have claimed that Africa has been held hostage from accepting humanitarian and social advancement for the past four-hundred years by tribal ideology and culture. It IS the male who perpetuates a Tribal Culture, which includes; brutal misogyny, corruption, genital mutilation, fierce ignorance, intentional fatherlessness and possible orphaning of their children, and deep poverty.

On October 22, 2019, with the aid of a Kiswahili interpreter, a simple five-question anonymous survey (see statements below) was conducted with 33 wives of Core 300--trained Kenyan or Ugandan Coordinators who had completed the **Warrior Course** sometime between the years 2013 and 2017. Most respondents answered all survey statements.

### 1. After my husband completed the Warrior Course (please check one box):

NOTE: This statement is only if your husband has beaten or abused you in the past.

He never abuses/beats me, and now treats me well	He abuses/beats me far less than before	He still abuses/beats me about the same	He abuses/beats me more than before	He abuses/beats me far more than before

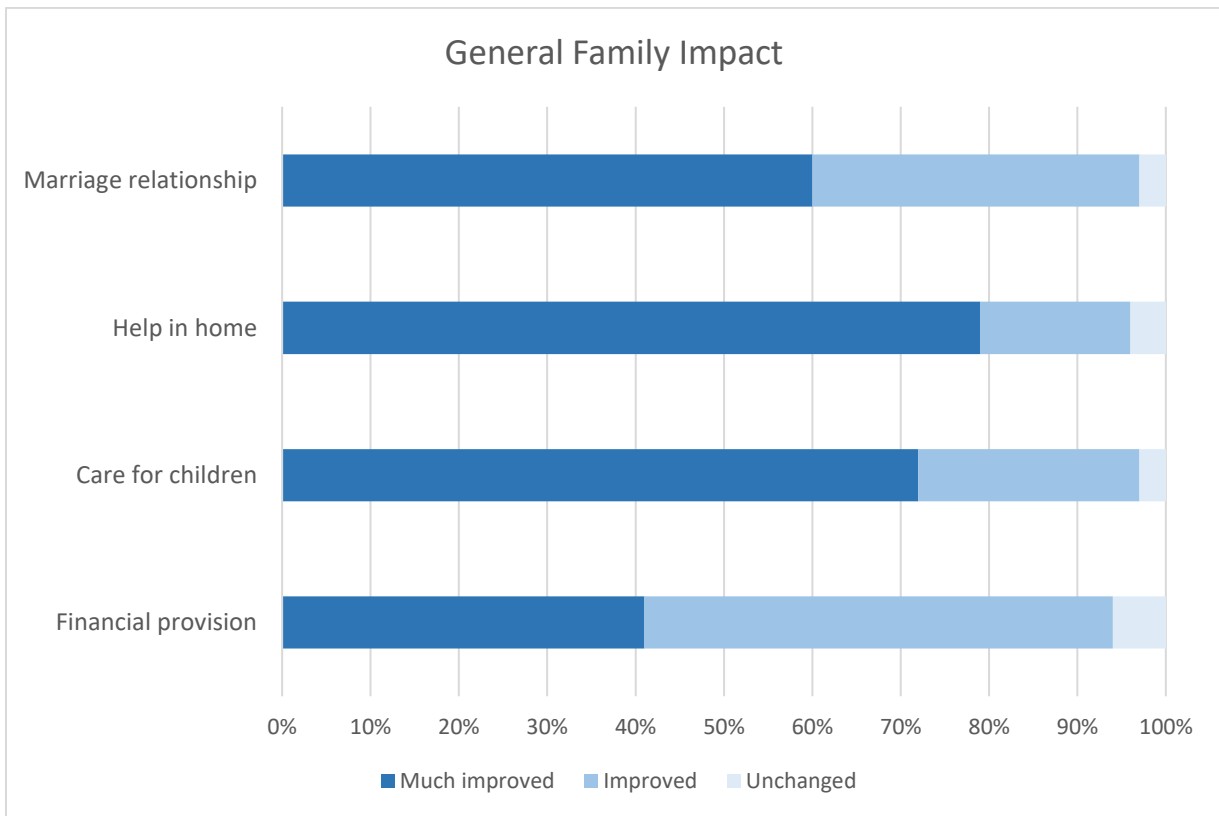
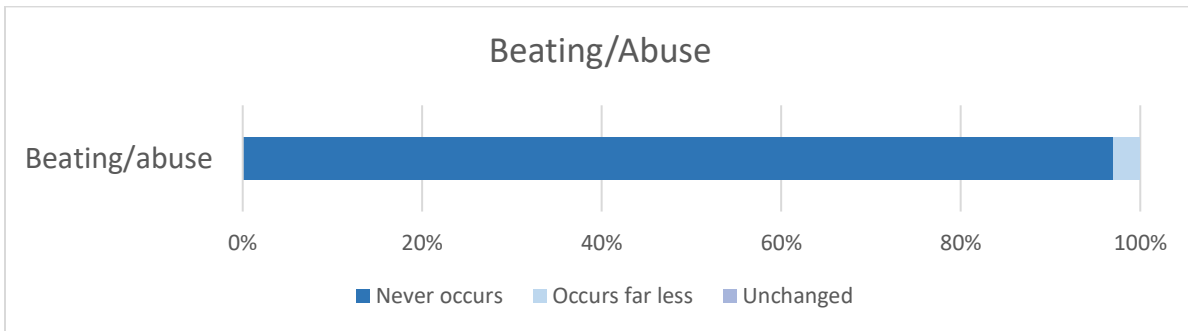
### 4. After my husband completed the Warrior Course, he:

# SURVEY GRAPHICAL RESULTS



## CONCLUSION

In all five areas measured, a profoundly positive (“much more” or “more”) improvement – 93% or more of the responses – was reported in each key category. As to wife abuse, every respondent was beaten prior to the course, forming a basis prior to the training. Afterward, 32 of 33 wives stated, *“He never abuses/beats me, and now treats me well.”* Leaving only one who scored *“He abuses/beats me far less than before.”* *Still an improvement.* No respondents scored in the “less” or “much less” to any statement.
